Easter Scavenger Hunt

Directions: Each team is given a Bible and a map. These are the only tools allowed. All 11 clues must be collected and kept <u>in order</u> to collect your prize. Teams must follow the map to know what areas are fair game or off limits.

Preparation: **Clues** are written or printed on different colored paper or post-its for each team. A clue of each color is **placed on or beside the named object**. For one team, Clue 1 is given to the group to start. Clue 2 is found on the Table, Clue 3 is found on the Bag, Clue 4 is found in the Bowl etc.. At the Stone, the paper will say, "You Did It!! Return to the beginning to collect your prize!" Each team's starting clue will be different so as to have them searching in a different order.

Objects to gather: Bag, Bowl, Cup, Silver (Chocolate) Coins, Sponge, Bucket of Water, White Cloth, Stone

Other items to prepare: **Maps** for each team marking spaces that are in play, **prize bags** for each participant with candy
